## **COVID-19 CONCERNS**

As I write this, the best advice is to continue to maintain shelter in place procedures, which means that the Temple will remain closed for all events and activities until further notice to protect everyone; notice of any change will be communicated as soon as we know it. Please watch for these notices.

Meantime, we will continue to reach out to members by phone, email and text, and will offer opportunities for our community to gather virtually by phone or online, and to share Shabbat services.

We commend to your attention the current advice: shelter in place as much as possible, wash your hands frequently, avoid touching your face, limit physical contact (hugging, kissing, hand shaking), remain at a social distance (six feet) from others, cover your mouth and nose if you cough or sneeze, wash clothing in the hottest water setting that they can tolerate, sanitize surfaces using cleaners that include disinfectants, and sanitize groceries or other items you bring into your home. If you are feeling ill, please remain at home and avoid others, unless it is severe and you need medical attention.

We are looking forward to a return to "normal" and the opportunity to gather again – we hope very soon. Once that is announced, we will re-institute our normal calendar of events in the Temple building.

Meantime, remember to wash your hands and avoid contact with anyone who may be ill. Stay healthy!

If you are having difficulties getting groceries or medicine, please call the Rabbi or email him.

There will be no April Bulletin. Instead, reminder emails will be sent out at the beginning and middle of each month until such time as we can again produce and mail a bulletin to you.
