

NOTICE – Temple Israel Cemetery Access Restriction

Temple Israel Cemetery

There was a slip in the Spring Hill Cemetery near the Temple Israel section. No graves or plots in the Temple Israel Section were affected. However, two of the roads used for access to the Temple Israel section are blocked due to repair work in an adjacent section of the Spring Hill Cemetery. Access is limited. Plan accordingly.

Please be advised that two of the roads serving the Temple Israel Cemetery – the upper road along the boundary, and the middle road inside through the cemetery – are closed to traffic because of work that is being done to repair a slip in an adjacent section of the Spring Hill Cemetery. There are cones marking the restricted access area, and construction vehicles blocking these two roads as they lead out of the Temple Israel Cemetery to the west so there is no passage on them.

It is unknown at this time how long these repairs will take.

The lower (third) road inside the Temple Israel Cemetery is open to traffic. Please be advised that this road is a cul-de-sac with a turning loop at the end (no exit to the west), which takes you back out through the pillars that mark the entrance to the Temple Israel Cemetery where you enter.

Photos show the area of the road blockages.

If you wish to visit a grave in the upper portion of the cemetery, you will need to park just inside the pillars and walk to that section, or park on the lower road and walk up the hill to the gravesite.

This notice is being sent to inform anyone who might be thinking of visiting the Cemetery of the situation. The situation is being addressed. We will let you know when it is resolved.
